Location: Carter Lake, Larimer County Recreation Area, West of Berthoud, CO

Dates: June 2nd – 3rd, 2007

1. Schedule of Events:

Saturday, June 2, 2007

07:30 to 09:00 Registration and Continental breakfast at clubhouse
10:00 Skippers meeting at the clubhouse
11:25 Warning signal for first race, addl. races to immediately follow
18:00 to 21:00 Refreshments at Clubhouse
18:00 Dinner served at the clubhouse

Sunday, June 3, 2007

07:30 to 09:30 Pancake breakfast at the clubhouse
09:00 Skippers meeting at clubhouse (if required - watch for notice posted before 20:00 on Saturday)
09:55 Warning signal for first race, addl. races to immediately follow
ASAP after last race - trophy presentation

No race will be started after 16:30 on Sat. or 14:30 on Sun.

2. Rules:

This Regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008.

3. Eligibility and Entry:

The event is open to all PHRF, One Design, Multi-Hull and Portsmouth boats that register and pay the fees. Boats racing in a PHRF fleet shall have a current PHRF Certificate issued by the SAIL PHRF Committee (visit www.rmsail.org for information). Boats racing One Design shall comply with their One Design Class rules. Portsmouth boats shall comply with all Portsmouth rules. Four boats will make a fleet.

4. Advance Registration:

Advance registration is highly encouraged. Advanced registrants get 2 nights slip usage free, first come first serve. Boats may register in advance by completing the registration form and sending it with appropriate fees to:

Advance registration shall be postmarked no later than Saturday, May 19, 2007 Entries mailed after this date will not be eligible for discounts and considerations.

5. Fees:

Regatta Entry Fees: \$50.00

Entry fee includes: Continental breakfast Saturday morning; Pancake breakfast Sunday morning; beverages Saturday evening; and trophies. Entry fee does not include vehicle, park or boat passes, available at the Marina or the park entry station, Saturday evening dinner at the clubhouse, or T-shirts.

Optional:

Dinner, Sat. evening (Adult) \$15.00
(Child under 12) \$8.00

Regatta T-shirt (short-sleeved) \$15.00
(long-sleeved) \$20.00

CLSC slip (see Accommodations) \$10.00/night (**2 nights free for advanced registrants**)

6. Measurement:

Measurement shall be governed by the individual class associations.

PHRF fleet boats must have a current PHRF certificate issued by S.A.I.L

7. Sailing Instructions:

Sailing instructions will be available at the registration.

8. Regatta Site:

The regatta site will be at North Pines Area of Carter Lake, Larimer County Recreation Area, West of Berthoud, Colorado

9. Accommodations:

Camping sites at the lake are available on a first come, first serve basis through Larimer County Parks. Motels are a 30-minute drive to Loveland or Longmont.

Carter Lake Marina will have overnight dry boat storage. Some moorings or slips will be available through the Marina. You may contact Carter Lake Marina at 970-667-1062. Rigged boats may be parked overnight in the parking lots next to North Pines boat ramp.

A limited number of slips will be available with Carter Lake Sailing Club on a first come, first serve basis through registration (**2 nights free for early registrants**).

10. Racing Area and Courses: Racing area and courses will be as shown on the Carter Lake Sailing Club 2007 Race Course Chart, available at registration.

11. Penalty System: Rule 44.2 Two Turn Penalty shall apply.

12. Scoring: The low point scoring system of Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008 will be used. All races sailed will be scored.

13. Trophies:

Fleets with four or less boats will be awarded first and second place trophies. Fleets with five or more boats will be awarded first, second and third place trophies.
