1. Schedule of Events:

11:25	Warning signal for first race, additional races to immediately follow
18:00 to 21:00	Refreshments and dinner at the clubhouse

Sunday, June 1, 2008

07:30 to 09:00	Continental breakfast at clubhouse
09:00	Skippers meeting at clubhouse (if required - watch for notice posted before 20:00 on Saturday)
09:55	Warning signal for first race, additional races to immediately follow
ASAP after last race - trophy presentation	
No race will be started after 16:00 on Sat., May 31 or 14:30 on Sun., June 1	

2. Rules:

This Regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in [The Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008](#).

3. Eligibility and Entry:

The event is open to all PHRF, One Design, Multi-Hull and Portsmouth boats that register and pay the fees. Boats racing in a PHRF fleet shall have a current PHRF Certificate issued by the SAIL PHRF Committee. Boats racing One Design shall comply with their One Design Class rules. Portsmouth boats shall comply with all Portsmouth rules. Four boats will make a fleet.

4. Advance Registration:

Early registration is highly encouraged. Boats may register in advance by completing the attached registration form and sending it with appropriate fees to:

Early registration forms should be postmarked no later than Saturday, May 3rd, 2008.

5. Fees:

Regatta Entry Fees: \$50.00 for all registrations

Entry fee includes: Pancake breakfast Saturday morning; continental breakfast Sunday morning; appetizers, soft drinks & beer Saturday evening; and trophies. Entry fee does not include, park passes for vehicle & boats, available at the Marina or the park entry station, Saturday evening dinner at the clubhouse, or T-shirts (although one free T-shirt is available with each early registration.)

6. Measurement:

Measurement shall be governed by the individual class associations. PHRF fleet boats must have a current PHRF certificate issued by S.A.I.L.

7. Sailing Instructions:

Sailing Instructions (SI's) will be available at the registration.

8. Regatta Site:

The regatta site will be at the North Pines Area of Carter Lake, Larimer County Recreation Area, West of Berthoud, Colorado

9. Accommodations:

We are arranging 10 – 12 slip spaces at Carter Lake Sailing Club which will be available on a first come, first serve basis through registration. The first 6 early registrations from traveling boats will be eligible to receive 2 nights of free slips. Some moorings or slips will be available through Carter Lake Marina. You can

contact the Marina at 970-667-1062. Carter Lake Marina and Carter Lake Sailing Club will have overnight dry boat storage.

There are a number of motels in Loveland and Longmont, approximately a 30 minute drive from the lake. Camping sites at the lake are available on a first come, first serve basis through Larimer County Parks.

10. Racing Area and Courses:

Racing area and courses will be as shown on the Carter Lake Sailing Club 2008 Race Course Chart, available at registration.

11. Penalty System:

Rule 44.2 Two Turn Penalty shall apply.

12. Scoring:

The low point scoring system of Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008 will be used. All races sailed will be scored.

13. Trophies:

Fleets with four or less boats will be awarded first and second place trophies. Fleets with more than five boats will be awarded first, second, and third place trophies.
