No race will be started after 16:00 on Sat., June 4 or 14:30 on Sun., June 5

2. Rules:

This Regatta will be governed by the 'rule' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008.

3. Eligibility and Entry:

The event is open to all PHRF, One Design, Multi-Hull and Portsmouth boats that register and pay the fees. Boats racing in a PHRF fleet shall have a current PHRF Certificate issued by the SAIL PHRF Committee. Boats racing One Design shall comply with their One Design Class rules. Portsmouth boats shall comply with all Portsmouth rules. Four boats will make a fleet.

4. Advance Registration:

Advance registration is highly encouraged. Boats may register in advance by completing the attached registration form and sending it with appropriate fees to:

Advance registration shall be postmarked no later than Saturday, May 20, 2006 Entries mailed after this date will not be eligible for discounts and considerations.

5. Fees:

Regatta Entry Fees: \$40.00 for US Sailing Members and/or **early registrants**

\$50 for all registrations received after the early registration deadline

Entry fee includes: Friday reception; pancake breakfast Saturday morning; continental breakfast Sunday morning; beverages Saturday evening; and trophies. Entry fee does not include vehicle, park or boat passes, available at the Marina or the park entry station, Saturday evening dinner at the clubhouse, or T-shirts.

6. Measurement:

Measurement shall be governed by the individual class associations. PHRF fleet boats must have a current PHRF certificate issued by S.A.I.L.

- 7. Sailing Instructions:**
Sailing instructions will be available at the registration.
- 8. Regatta Site:**
The regatta site will be at Carter Lake, Larimer County Recreation Area, West of Berthoud, Colorado
- 9. Accommodations:**
Camping sites at the lake are available on a first come, first serve basis through Larimer County Parks. Motels are a 30-minute drive to Loveland or Longmont.
Carter Lake Marina and Carter Lake Sailing Club will have overnight dry boat storage. Some moorings or slips will be available through the Marina, and a limited number of slips may be available with Carter Lake Sailing Club on a first come, first serve basis through registration. - 10. Racing Area and Courses:**
Racing area and courses will be as shown on the Carter Lake Sailing Club 2006 Race Course Chart, available at registration.
- 11. Penalty System:**
Rule 44.2 Two Turn Penalty shall apply.
- 12. Scoring:**
The low point scoring system of Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008 will be used. All races sailed will be scored.
- 13. Trophies:**
Fleets with four or less boats will be awarded first and second place trophies. Fleets with five to eight boats will be awarded first, second, and third place trophies. Fleets with over eight boats will be awarded first, second, third and fourth place trophies.
