#### **2. Rules:**

This Regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in The Racing Rules of sailing 2017-2020

#### **3. Eligibility and Entry:**

The event is open to all PHRF, One design, Multi-Hull and Portsmouth boat that register and pay the fee's. Boats racing in a PHRF fleet shall have a current PHRF certificate issued by the SAIL PHRF Committee. Otherwise, a PHRF rating can be assigned for a \$5 fee at the Open. Boats racing One design shall comply with their One Design Class rules. Portsmouth boats shall comply with all Portsmouth rules. Four boats will make a fleet.

#### **4. Advance Registration:**

Early Registration is highly encouraged. Boats may register in advance by registering online at [www.sailcarter.org](http://www.sailcarter.org), or by sending a completed registration form with the appropriate fees to:

#### **5. Fees:**

Regatta Entry Fees before May 29: \$60.00 for all registrations

-\$5 for RM SAIL members

Registration fee after May 29: \$75.00

Entry fee does not include park passes for vehicles or boats, available at the Marina or park entry station, Saturday evening dinner at the clubhouse, or

#### **6. Measurement**

Measurement shall be governed by the individual class associations. PHRF fleet boats must have a PHRF certificate issued by S.A.I.L.

#### **7. Sailing Instructions:**

Sailing Instructions; (SI's) will be available at registration.

#### **8. Regatta Site:**

The regatta site will be at the North Pines Area of Carter Lake, Larimer County Recreation Area, west of Berthoud, Colorado.

#### **9. Accommodations**

Some moorings or slips will be available through the Carter Lake Marina.

You can contact the Marina at 970-667-1062.

#### **10. Racing Area and Courses:**

Racing area will be shown on the Carter Lake Sailing Club Race Course Chart, available at registration.

#### **11. Penalty System**

Rule 44.2 One-Turn and Two Turns Penalty shall apply.

**12. Scoring:**

The low point scoring system of Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 will be used. All races sailed will be scored.

**13. Trophies:**

Fleets with four or less boats will be awarded first and second place trophies.  
Fleets with five or more boats will be awarded first, second and third place.
